



Vinyl Window Terminology

1. Head

The top part of the window frame, going across from one side to another.

2. Jamb

The vertical portions of the window frame that make up its side

3. Sash

Stiles and rails, which surround each insulated glass combine to form a single sash in turn operated up, down, side to side, outward, or inward depending on product

Single panes insulated together.

4. Insulated Glass

Single panes insulated together

5. Pane

A single piece of glass

6. Frame

The entire window's outside edges, or the head, jambs and sill combined

7. Sill

This is the lower equivalent of the head.

8. Grids or Muntin Bar

Decorative option that goes between the panes of an insulated glass
